

## **Travel permit**

The travel permit is an authorization for a minor for the entry into or exit from Argentina, granted by those who exercise parental responsibility over said minor.

The permit can authorize the minor either to travel alone, with the other parent or with a third party.

The travel permit can be signed both at the Argentine Embassy in Sweden and before a local notary public.

There are two types of travel permit: entry permit and exit permit.

- Entry permit. Required for minors under 13 years old, both Argentine and foreign, when they are not accompanied (or expected at destination) by any of the holders of parental responsibility. If the minor travels only with one holder of parental responsibility, he/she must obtain travel permit from the other holder.

- Exit permit. Required for minors under 18 years old, both Argentine and foreign, when they departure from Argentina without any of the holders of parental responsibility. Exceptions: this permit is not required when: 1) The minor is Argentine who has residence abroad. 2) The minor is a foreigner that holds temporary residence in Argentina, provided that he/she has not stayed more than 90 days in the country.

## **Procedure at the Embassy**

Fee: amount in SEK equivalent to USD 50 at the exchange rate of the processing day. The exact amount in SEK is informed during the signage appointment.

## **Steps**

1° | Request an appointment by email to [consulares\\_esuec@mrecic.gov.ar](mailto:consulares_esuec@mrecic.gov.ar) informing name and surname, DNI number (if you are Argentine) or passport number (if you are not Argentine) and -if you wish- preference of days for the appointment.

If you live outside of Stockholm, you can request an appointment for one of our consular visits to the interior of Sweden. Upcoming visits: Malmö 10/18/2018 | Göteborg 10/19/2018.

2° | Wait for the appointment arrangement by the Embassy, about which you will be informed by email within 2 business days after the appointment request.

3° | Attend the appointment bringing the required documents for the procedure. The minor is not required to attend the appointment.

#### Required documents

1 | Argentine DNI, if Argentine, or foreign passport, if not Argentine.

2 | Birth certificate of the minor. If a Swedish birth certificate (personbevis) is submitted, it must be signed and stamped by Skatteverket official.

3 | Copy of passport of minor and authorized person to travel with him.

If your appointment was scheduled for one of our consular visits to the interior of Sweden, you must also submit a photocopy of your Argentine DNI or foreign passport and the birth certificate.

#### Procedure before a notary public

The fee to be paid and documentation to be submitted must be informed by the notary public.

The travel permit issued before a notary public must be legalized with apostille and be accompanied by a Spanish translation.

In these cases, it is also suggested to travel with a birth certificate translated into Spanish.
