Power of attorney

Both Argentine and foreign citizens can grant power of attorney under Argentine law at the Argentine Embassy in Sweden.

Upon signage, the grantor is given a testimony (copy) of this power of attorney which he/she must send to his/her agent in Argentina. The original document is kept in the Embassy's Notary Record Book.

Fee: amount in SEK equivalent to USD 40 per every 25 lines or fraction under 25 lines, at the exchange rate valid on the payment day. Note that the lines of the testimony (copy) are also taken into account to calculate the total cost. The exact amount in SEK is informed at the Embassy.

Exception: fee is not charged when the power of attorney revolves around a pension or benefit granted as compensation for human rights violations.

<u>Instructions to grant a power of attorney:</u>

1° | Request appointment by e-mail at consulares_esuec@mrecic.gov.ar informing full name and – optional– choice of days for appointment. Appointments are scheduled for Monday through Friday from 11:00 to 15:00, except holidays.

Attach to the e-mail scanned copy of your DNI, if you are Argentine, or your passport, if you are foreigner, and the text that must be included in the power of attorney (in Word). It is advised to commission the composition of the text to a lawyer.

- 2° | Await the arrangement of the appointment by the Embassy, about which you will be informed by email within two working days.
- 3° | Attend the appointment at the Embassy bringing your DNI or passport. Embassy staff will examine the documents and will then instruct you to pay the fee to start the procedure.

Note:

All of the aforementioned also applies to the revocation of power previously granted, regardless of public authority before which it was granted in the past.
