If you need this visa, require the educational institution to carry out this registration and application for “entry permit” before you submit the visa application to the Embassy.</p>

As regards the son or daughter, if their parent is a foreigner holder of family reunification visa –not an Argentine citizen– he she can only obtain this visa as long as he she is under 18 years old.</p> <p style="color: red;">-Although this visa allows the holder to stay in Argentina with no time limit, Dirección Nacional de Migraciones (DNM) may cancel the visa if the visa holder stays outside of Argentina for more than 2 years.</p>

If the applicant is not native to the MERCOSUR state concerned, it is required that he she has held the citizenship of that state for already 5 years. According to Argentine law, holders of this visa can apply for Argentine citizenship after they have stayed in Argentina for at least 2 years.</p>

<sup>1</sup>Exception: The fee is USD 250 for holders of passports issued by Kosovo, Saharai Republic and Taiwan.

## References:

1. The invitation letter must be written in Spanish and addressed to the Embassy (Embajada de la República Argentina – Box 140 39 – 104 40 – Stockholm). This letter must be certified by a public notary and legalized by the notaries college (colegio de escribanos) in Argentina. Exception: In the case of 23G religious visa, the letter must be certified by the Dirección General del Registro Nacional de Culto. Note: If the inviting party resides in Sweden as well as the visa applicant, the letter must be signed and certified at the Embassy, either at the same visa appointment or at a different appointment which should be requested.

--The letter must contain the following information: full name or company name, DNI or CUIT, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the inviting party; full name, nationality, passport number, date and place of birth, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the applicant; purpose of the trip; relationship between inviting party and applicant; estimated arrival and departure dates; intended length of the stay in Argentina; accommodation address; information related to whom will cover the expenses, and indication that the applicant has been informed that he|she must leave the country before the allowed period of stay is expired. In case of 23G religious visa, the following information should be also featured in the letter: community, congregation or diocese where activities will take place; sort of activity to be carried out (pastoral, teaching, etc).

--The letter must mention the registration number of the inviting party under the Registro Nacional Único de Requirentes (RENURE) under the Immigration Department (Dirección Nacional de Migraciones). The registration under RENURE must still be valid and, if the inviting party is a company, the signer of the letter must be the same person whose signature was registered under RENURE. Argentina's Catholic Church is exempted from the registration requirement under RENURE. Registration under RENURE is not required for visa 24 A (tourist) either.

--If more than one person is invited, all of them can be included in one single invitation letter, but the list of invitees should be included in the letter –not separately as an annex-.

--A model of the invitation letter –in Spanish- can be found on the next two pages (below).

2. Criminal record issued by Sweden must carry apostille and be translated into Spanish. Translation into Spanish is not necessary if the “utlande” criminal record is submitted. Criminal records from other countries must be legalized by the Argentine Embassy or Consulate that has jurisdiction over issuing country. Applicants under 16 years old are exempted from submitting criminal record.

3. The labour agreement must be written in Spanish, certified by a public notary (escribano público) and legalized by the notaries college (colegio de escribanos). The agreement must contain the following information: full name or company name, DNI or CUIT, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the employer; full name, nationality, passport number, date and place of birth, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the applicant (employee); activity for which he|she is hired; work address; working conditions; salary; estimated date for the beginning of the employment, and duration of the labour agreement. The agreement must mention the registration number of the employer under the Registro Nacional Único de Requirentes (RENURE) under the Immigration Department (Dirección Nacional de Migraciones). The registration under RENURE must still be valid and, if the employer is a company, the signer of the labour agreement must be the same person whose signature was registered under RENURE.

4. Certificates issued by Sweden (personbevis) must be translated into Spanish and carry apostille. Certificates issued by other countries must be legalized by the Argentine Embassy or Consulate that has jurisdiction over the issuing country.

5. The note or labour certificate must be written in Spanish, certified by a public notary (escribano público) and legalized by the notaries college (colegio de escribanos). It must contain the following information: full name or company name, DNI or CUIT, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the entity; full name, nationality, passport number, date and place of birth, permanent address, telephone number and e-mail address of the applicant (transferred officer); relationship between transferred officer and the entity; reason and duration of the transfer. The note or certificate must mention the registration number of the entity under the Registro Nacional Único de Requirentes (RENURE) under the Immigration Department (Dirección Nacional de Migraciones). The registration under RENURE must still be valid and the signer of the note or certificate must be the same person whose signature was registered under RENURE.
